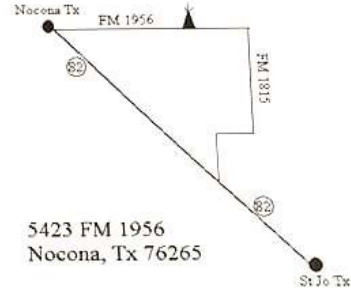

RECIPE— HOLIDAY WASSAIL

Serves 20

Ingredients:

- 1 gallon apple cider
- 1 large can pineapple juice (unsweetened)
- 3/4 cup tea (can use herb tea)

Place in a cheesecloth sack:

- 1 Tablespoon whole cloves
- 1 Tablespoon whole allspice
- 2 sticks cinnamon

Instructions: Let it simmer very slowly for 4 to 6 hours. You can add water if it evaporates too much.
